- Work collaboratively with subject matter experts (SMEs), instructional designers, curriculum development practitioners and other stakeholders to translate module outcomes into engaging, interactive, and pedagogically sound online content.
- Update and revise module content as needed to reflect changes in curriculum, new instructional strategies, or technological enhancements.
