- Full proficiency in English is a prerequisite.
- Registration with the HPCSA as an Environmental Health Practitioner is compulsory for the following subjects: CDV206P, IDE206P, WQW307P, EEM307P, OHS408P and OHS307P. Regarding other subjects registration or membership with a professional body will be an added advantage.
- Completion of a TUT License to Teach programme will be compulsory.
