MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Design, implement and maintain an aviation safety management plan at the AMO.
- Ensure that the Safety management plan remains current.
- Develop and update the company's safety policies, procedures, and standards in accordance with national and international aviation regulations, industry guidelines, and best practices.
- Oversee the implementation and maintenance of an effective Safety Management System, including risk assessment, incident reporting, investigation, and analysis.
- Represents the organization on government, international organization and industry committees (e.g. ICAO, IATA, CAA, AIB, etc.).
- Conduct risk assessments on all safety incident reports
- Determine the appropriate preventative or corrective measures, after investigations and risk assessments have been carried out, to all hazardous safety incidents
- Conduct studies to predict and identify future or potential threats to safety
- Review any directives, plans and programmes which may have an impact on aviation safety
- Take part, as required, in accident, incident or occurrence investigations
- Model and promote an organizational culture that fosters safety practices through effective leadership and training.
- Conduct regular audits and inspections of operational activities, facilities, and equipment to identify safety deficiencies and areas for improvement.
- Recommend corrective actions and monitor implementation.
- Act as an information conduit to bring safety issues to the attention of management and to deliver safety information to the organization's staff, contractors and stakeholders.
